DEAR FRIENDS & SUPPORTERS,

Our team has never been under this much spiritual attack since I founded And Then There Were None in 2012. I also don't think we - me included - have experienced this level of intense healing, either. God is moving, and we are following.

The attacks are confirmation that we are heading in the right direction, armed with the truth that the enemy doesn't want to be known. We approached 2024 with a commitment to be bold in truth and walk in love, ready for whatever consequences may come. This is the only way we can bring down the abortion giant, and we are not afraid.

"God will rescue you from the fowler's snare...will shelter you with pinions, spread wings that you may take refuge. God's faithfulness is a protecting shield." - Psalm 91:4

In 2024, I felt like our public image needs to reflect the boldness of our Quitters. Trust me, it's not easy to share all your worst sins in public, but we believe it is necessary to end the murders we participated in. We rebranded in 2024 to communicate the fierce courage of abortion industry Quitters and God's unconditional love for humble sinners. Ex-abortion workers can confidently move forward in their healing and share their powerful stories trusting in His love and mercy.

I'm standing under His protection with 725 chinks in the abortion industry's armor, and that number is growing, weakening the enemy's defenses. Two exabortion clinic managers are now part of our staff, and I am overjoyed to share their roles and stories with you in this report. YOU made it possible for us to hire them while God made it possible for them to leave the abortion industry and find healing.

As one of our recent Quitters and former Planned Parenthood manager, Christine, said: "Everyone equally hated the place. No one had pride in working for Planned Parenthood. Everyone seemed drained. Everyone seemed withdrawn. Everyone genuinely hated the place."

Yes, even in her New York affiliate, no one grew up wanting to work in an abortion clinic. It's a trap set by the enemy to seduce workers and women into participating in child sacrifice.

We can get them out. We can walk them into a relationship with Jesus Christ, and together, we can shut down their former satanic altars.

Your partnership with And Then There Were None radically changes lives, saves souls, and impacts generations. Let's end abortion from the inside out together in 2025.

Of the 226 abortion facilities they represent, 55 are now PERMANENTLY CLOSED.

That's a 24.3% closure rate when an abortion worker contacts ATTWN!

We mailed 16,869 postcards and handwritten **cards** to abortion clinics encouraging workers to leave their jobs.





We helped our Quitters share their stories publicly nearly 1,167 times with their eyewitness accounts to shed light on the abortion industry.

Our Quitters were featured in 227 coverage pieces and 79 radio and TV interviews, with an estimated online readership of 11,656,700,200!





We provided nearly 2,300 hours of licensed counseling for our Quitters.

We spent over 360 hours on sidewalks outside of abortion clinics, praying and building relationships with abortion workers.



We awarded four scholarships for Quitters to advance their credentials in the medical field in honor of the late Dr. Nancy Sandrock.



We connected 21 abortion industry whistleblowers with legal advocacy.

Connected monthly via live video chats with our Quitters for group therapy on our Connect + Care chats led by licensed therapist Dr. Amanda Willie.

Continued our monthly Bible studies led by Director of Operations, Angela Huguenin, to all Quitters via live video chat!





Grew our discipleship program with Client Advocate & pastor's wife, Sarah Taylor, to deepen 12 Quitters' individual relationships with Christ.

We provided 48 NEW Quitters of the abortion industry with financial aid, resumé and job search assistance, and spiritual and emotional support, and welcomed them with Love Boxes loaded with ATTWN goodies and Bibles.



15 Quitters received financial coaching with our Dave Ramsey-certified financial coach.

Hosted 44 Quitters on healing retreats throughout 2024!





EXODUS 2024:







ON EXODUS DAY, NO ONE WALKS OUT ALONE.

When Abby Johnson founded And Then There Were None in 2012, she estimated about ten abortion workers per year would call the hotline for assistance.

To her surprise, she began immediately getting calls from about ten workers per month.

Understaffed, underfunded, but not undetermined, ATTWN has trusted in God's provision for each worker. He has not failed any of them.

Recalling the anxiety of taking that step out of the abortion industry, Abby was inspired to host a day of Exodus in 2013. Exodus was a mass walkout from the abortion industry, and ATTWN stood ready to assist.

Coincidentally,

Exodus 20:13 says: "You shall not kill."

Fifteen Quitters were added to the ATTWN fold that day.

Ten years later in 2023, we hosted another Exodus Day in partnership with prayer warriors and sidewalk advocates and added another 15 new Quitters.

Nine of the 15 workers who quit on Exodus Day in 2023 were from one Planned Parenthood affiliate, causing abortions to completely halt without enough staff to do their dirty work. We don't know how many lives were saved, but as Mother Teresa encouraged us, "We are not called to be successful; we are called to be faithful."

Walking in faith and obedience, ATTWN has decided to make Exodus Day an annual event! In 2024, we held another Exodus Day on Good Friday...with another 15 new abortion industry Quitters. Our team is strategizing additional ways to reach Quitters beyond technological and physical boundaries in ways that are peaceful, prayerful, and effective.

Please continue your prayers on the sidewalk - they save lives, and souls.

LOVE. NO MATTER WHAT:

PLANNED PARENTHOOD CONTINUES TO CALL THEIR SERVICES 'HEALTHCARE.'

We don't think that word means what they think it means. We put four former Planned Parenthood employees in a room together for a discussion that unmasked the abortion giant's facade of 'Care. No matter what.'

With a combined 33 years of Planned Parenthood work experience between them, Abby Johnson and Mayra Rodriguez, both former Planned Parenthood Directors, along with Annette Lopez, a former Planned Parenthood Sex Educator, and Socorro Rodriguez, a former Planned Parenthood Healthcare Assistant, debunked every myth and lie used to sell abortions.

Quitters are former abortion workers who have laid down their abortion instruments, discarded the warped justifications that led them to the industry, and have the courage to admit they were wrong.

They won't stop there: Quitters are taking action and speaking up to end the atrocities they witnessed. While the abortion culture wants to silence them, And Then There Were None has given them a platform to amplify their voices.

LITTLE PILLS THAT KILL



Medication abortion now accounts for 63% of all clinician-provided abortions in the United States, varying as high as 95% of abortions performed in some states.

Alarmingly, this doesn't include abortion pills obtained through mail-order services from all over the world, which anyone can access online.

When we say 'anyone,' we mean...anyone—minors, abusive partners, sex traffickers, with or without the woman's consent.

ATTWN's ex-abortion workers know the drill after witnessing and administering medication abortions for the past two decades in clinical settings. They were told to look the other way when fully informed consent wasn't provided or when they suspected coerced abortions.

Until they couldn't look the other way any longer.

Last year, we launched Little Pills That Kill, a landing page loaded with facts, statistics, and stories of everything wrong with abortion pills and the precious lives they terminate.

We continued these stories from the perspective of the patients--women who know firsthand that

abortion pills, in reality, are not the easy, effective, light-as-a-period abortion method they were sold as.

These little pills kill.





08. UN THINK ABLE:

UNTHINKABLE Film Updates



After completing the first draft and preliminary screenings of the UNTHINKABLE documentary, we realized that many of the stories and recordings that didn't make the final cut are absolutely essential to the film's mission.

The end of abortion will not begin until the unimaginable horrors

that persist in the abortion industry are exposed.

Our culture has to see to believe the violent destruction and discard of human lives killed by abortion. With this realization, Abby Johnson has made the difficult yet necessary decision to part with the first draft of the film and go back through the editing process to achieve the documentary's original vision and intent. UNTHINKABLE is now under the financial oversight of And Then There Were None, and all contributions to the final production are tax-deductible. The final release will hit theaters in winter of 2025, but we need your help.

And Then There Were None is blessed with many behind-the-scenes prayer warriors and volunteers. Our handwritten card ministry is composed of hundreds of fully vetted and trained card writers who craft peaceful, loving messages to actively open abortion-providing and abortion referral clinics all over the nation each month. They've asked to remain nameless, but we can't fail to mention them and give them our heartfelt thanks in this report. You know who you are. Thank you for loving workers out of the industry, one by one.

Additionally, we have another team of card writers with a special mission and focus. Since 2021, nuns from 16 different convents have been writing and mailing Christmas cards to every abortion and referral facility.

They receive more hateful responses than positive ones, but these Sisters aren't backing down. For every pro-death response, they pray harder, trusting that God can draw the most vehemently pro-abortion workers out of the industry.

One of their Christmas cards landed in the hands of a young abortion clinic manager in New York named Christine. This is what she shared with ATTWN:



One day, while my employees were on break, I intercepted the mail. A pretty envelope with no return address caught my eye, and I opened it. I still have it, this beautiful Christmas card. It was handwritten, and I could tell that it was personalized. It basically said, 'Are you looking for a way out? We can help you get out of the abortion industry; call this number.'

I asked a colleague if the letter was real, and she said it was fake; don't pay any attention to it. Something prompted me, which I know is the Holy Spirit, to put it in my bag and bring it home.

I called the [ATTWN] hotline. She [ATTWN's Intake Manager] was the sweetest thing on this planet. I do not like crying, but as soon as she started talking, the waterworks started. It just felt like it was way too good to be true. I'd been praying every day to get out of this industry."

Christine is worth all the hate mail in the world. Led by this encouragement, our card writers will continue writing until there are none.

ARMED [WITH] & DANGEROUS

[TO THE ABORTION INDUSTRY]

And Then There Were None connects every abortion worker who contacts the hotline with a Client Advocate to walk alongside them in their exit from the abortion industry and in their healing journey. Some of our advocates have been with the ministry since we began operations, and each is fully dedicated to our mission.

However, something has been missing for quite some time, and we didn't understand the disconnect. Finally, in 2024, we discerned what it was - it takes a Quitter to know one. Specifically, we needed Noemi Padilla

Noemi, a former nurse manager of Tampa Women's Center in Florida, had already assisted nine of her former employees - plus the abortion doctor - in leaving the abortion industry forever. It seemed only natural to bring her on board as ATTWN's Client Support Specialist to bridge the gap of trust between the abortion worker and the Client Advocate.

Noemi worked at the clinic for four years but knew she didn't belong there after the first year. However, she had already hired many women and felt deeply responsible for them. She made it her mission to bridge them to safety outside the clinic's employment.

Relationships between abortion clinic staff and people on the sidewalk grew. Through them, she also learned about And Then There Were None. She began encouraging her staff to contact ATTWN as their ticket to freedom. She was determined to get everyone out - nobody left behind.

"I stayed with them," Noemi recalls. "I stayed there long enough for them to all quit. I finally woke up one Monday morning and said, 'God, I can't put on another pair of scrubs and go to work. I can't do this anymore.' And then I just heard His voice saying, 'Well, you don't have to do this. You can quit."

Noemi had her first deep conversation with God in her four years as an abortion nurse. In civilian



clothing, she walked into the clinic and announced her resignation.

"It was hard because I knew firsthand that once you quit the abortion industry, you're shunned. They are going to lie. They are going to say anything they can say to discredit the person who's quitting. I knew that they make it so that you are so dependent on having to come back to the abortion clinic and beg for your job back," Noemi says.

"I was choosing life. I wasn't choosing death anymore," Noemi proclaims. "I went to the beach. I cried a lot. And when I got home from the beach, there was a voicemail from a company saying they had my resumé sitting on their desk and they wanted to offer me a position."

"So if that is not God. I don't know."

Noemi is excited and honored in her new role as ATTWN's Client Support Specialist while also working as a nurse for a pregnancy center in Florida. In both roles, she is saving lives from the abortion industry, particularly from her former employer.

"When you've been at such a horrific job where we were nothing but dishonest, and everything was a lie, it's so freeing to have not just one, but two jobs for the Lord saving lives. It's just amazing," Noemi exclaims.

She explains her hopes for her position at ATTWN, "I want to be able to effectively be that bridge for a Quitter.Maybe I can give them a different outlook and successfully get them to acknowledge that we're trying to do the right thing by them."
